Must fill out TA request sheet

- Science Olympiad

Will be a $2^{\text {nd }}$ semester class only, for students who are members of the Science Olympiad. To be a member of Science Olympiad, students must be committed for the entire year, maintain a 3.0 GPA, attend all after school practices and competitions, and have a parent/adult who volunteers. There are 3 times a week after-school practices from mid-September to May. There are 23 different events with real world application of science concepts. Anyone who is committed for the entire year can be on the Junior Varsity team.
